3. The most frequently used one is "love one another."

III. Love One Another Stated Negatively

1. We should not betray one another – Matthew 24:10
2. We should not hate one another – Matthew 24:10; Titus 3:33
3. We should not judge one another – Romans 14:13
4. We should not bite and devour one another – Galatians 5:15
5. We should not be challenging and one another – Galatians 5:26
6. We should not lie to one another – Colossians 3:9
7. We should not complain against one another – James 5:9

IV. Some Things to Remember About I John 2:9-11

1. Hate is our way of extracting payment from someone for something they said or did to us that Jesus already paid for. – v. 2:2
2. Hate compromises your spiritual immune system thus causing you to easily stumble – v. 2:10
 - a. Psalm 119:165; II Timothy 2:24-26
3. Hatred stunts your growth. It affects your vision. "He is so mad he cannot see straight."
4. "No man is fit to give a verdict on anything while he has hated in his heart; and no man can rightly direct his own life when hatred dominates him." – William Barclay
