II. Today's Text – vs. 21-25

A. What to do for others – vs. 22-23

(Remember you cannot minister to others if you are not spiritually healthy)

- 1. Have mercy on some who are doubting v. 22
 - a. Be patient with them
 - b. These are believers who have been confused by false teachers
 - c. Some translations read "convince" versus have "mercy"
 - i. Il Ťimothy 4:2
 - d. "mercy" first usage Matthew 5:7; 14:3
- 2. "save others, snatching them out of the fire" v. 23a
 - a. Same word used in I Thessalonians 4:17 and Revelation 12:5
 - b. This must refer to non-believers i. Matthew 25:41
 - c. The fire of God's judgement v. 7
 i. Mathew 25:46; Revelation 20:15
 - d. The gospel is the only way to do this i. John 3:16; 5:24
- 3. "and on some have mercy with fear" v. 23b
 - a. Believers or non-believers?
 - b. I think believers
 - c. Not all commentators see a third group. My point is that ministry is for the spiritual healthy!
 - i. Galatians 6:1-4
- B. What to do for our God and Savior vs. 24, 25

(Thid is considered by some to be the greatest Benediction-Doxology in the New Testament)

- 1. This really is about what He will do for us. Jude sums it up in two ways.
 - a. He is able to keep us from stumbling
 - i. Psalm 119:165; I Corinthians 15:33
 - b. He is able to make us stand blameless and with joy
 i. Luke 22:31, 32
- 2. This is more about what we should do for Him
 - a. He is called "God and Savior"
 - i. I Timothy 1:1
 - b. He is due:
 - i. Glory: the brightness and excellence of God
 - ii. Majesty: the incomparable regal presence of our God
 - iii. Dominion: the infinite extent of the rules of our God
 - iv. Authority: Power and might of our God

 - 1. Before all time Revelation 1:8
 - a. Psalm 90:1, 2
 - 2. Now Revelation 1:8
- 3. Forever Revelation 1:8
 - a. Issaih 40:28
