I. A Chronology of the Four Gospels

- 1. The Resurrection
- 2. An Earthquake
- 3. Descent of an Angel Matthew 28:2-4
- 4. Opening of the Tomb
- 5. Guards terrified
- 6. A group of women head for the grave while it is still dark. John 20:1, 2; Matthew 28:1; Mark 16:1
 - a. Mary Magdalene arrives first
 - b. She finds the tomb empty
 - c. She goes to tell Peter and John
- 7. The other women arrive. Mark 16:2-4
 - a. A two mile walk from Bethany.
- 8. An angel appears and gives them a message for the disciples. Matthew 28:5-8; Mark 16:5-8
- 9. Another group of women arrive later and see two angels. Luke 24:1-9
 - a. They receive words of comfort and instruction.
- 10. About 6:30 a.m. Peter and John arrive John first. John 20:3-10
- 11. Mary Magdalene follows later and sees two angels. – John 20:11-13
- 12. The other women report to the disciples. Luke 24:10
- 13. About 7:00 a.m. Jesus first reveals Himself to Mary Magdalene. – John 20:14-18; Mark 16:9 (#1)
- 14. Jesus appears to a group of women. Matthew 28:9-11 (#2)

- a. Jesus tells them to instruct His disciples to meet Him in Galilee.
- 15. About 4:00 p.m. Jesus appears to Peter. Luke 24:34; I Corinthians 15:5 (#3)
- 16. From 4-6 p.m. Jesus appears to Cleophas and his friend. Luke 24:13-32 (#4)
 - a. They go back to Jerusalem to tell the Apostles. Luke 24:33
- 17. Around 8:00 p.m. Jesus appears to the Apostles, minus Thomas. – Luke 24:36-43; John 20:19-25 (#5)
