A. The message – v. 5

1. Positively stated – "God is light"
 - a. Exodus 15:11; Psalm 111: 9; I Timothy 6:16
2. Negatively stated – "In Him there is no darkness at all" – Job 34:10; Habakuk 1:13
3. Its meaning: To have fellowship with God sin must be dealt with:
 - a. Positionally – Colossians 1:12, 13
 - b. Experientially – Romans 6
 - c. God the Light exposes man's sin as well as condemns it.

 - c. We then think we can deceive God – v. 10

1. Our responsibility – v. 9a
 - a. "confess": to say the same thing about sin that God does
2. His responsibility (promise) – v. 9b
 - a. Forgive our sins
 - i. Psalm 86:3; 103:1-14
3. Cleanse us from all unrighteousness
 - a. Consequences of dishonesty – v. 10
4. We make Him a Liar
5. His Word is not in us
